Wave of MINISTRY

We are hoping to receive the building permit in the next couple of months, after which we will break ground and begin construction.







OUTREACH

Your Cannonball contributions are already starting to make waves in other parts of Florida:

- A \$50,000 special gift from Community was delivered by Pastor Scott to Greg Ingram, the Pastor of Miami Church, a church we have been supporting since their launch.
- In January we committed \$100,000 over the next 3 years to help launch Connection Point Church, a new church plant in Pensacola, Florida! Connection Point will hold their first service on Sunday, April 7.



As Community continues to make a big splash in South Florida and with these two church plants in other parts of our state, we also want those ripples to go around the world. Associate Pastor Bill Davis recently returned from a scouting trip with Pastor Jose Rodriguez and we are looking forward to help plant a Christian Church in a growing community in Panama City, Panama. We will partner with Lifeline Christian Mission and with Pastor Jose, who is from Panama and has been successfully planting churches in El Salvador for the past 13 years.

Consider joining a team from Community on a mission trip to Panama August 4 – 10 to meet people in the community where the church will be planted and put on a KIDZ Camp that will draw families for the purpose of getting to know them. The new church will launch at the beginning of 2020.
