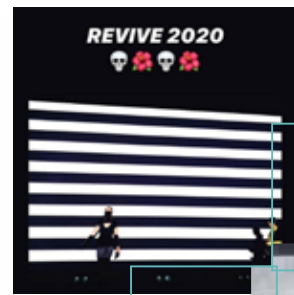

# wave of MINISTRY

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, this summer has looked like no other summer in the history of Community. The usual summer events for Community Kids and Community Students —Kids Camp, Summer Camp at Lake Aurora, and the Christ In Youth MOVE Conference—did not happen in the way we're used to. Despite that, our Kids and Students teams did a GREAT job of planning online alternatives. Community Students held two back-to-back weeks of their online Revive Camp and had over 230 students involved. The best news of all about Revive: 10 students have decided to follow Jesus and be baptized into Him! The 2020 Kids Camp moved online, too, and we had nearly 400 preschool and elementary kids registered to participate in this online program. Our Women's Ministry held its first online-only event on Saturday, August 1 with over 500 women watching from home. And our Outreach Ministry has been busy this summer, hosting monthly food distribution events in partnership with Feeding South Florida, the City of Tamarac, and Broward Sheriff's Office.

This is one of the latest aerial photos of the NextGen Building taken from the south.



The current building is in the process of being painted to match the new building, a combination of gray, white, and blue.



This large space is for our kids K - 5. This room will be divided by an operable wall into two separate rooms where our elementary children will have their worship experience and break down into small groups.

This large space is where our middle school and high school students will meet for worship. The stage will be in the left corner and the rest of the room will be wide open for LIFE Groups to break out and meet together



This photo is taken from the second floor outdoor Terrace looking down into the Courtyard. On the right is the new outdoor baptistry. On the left, you'll notice the columns that will support the covered walkway that will connect the NextGen Building with our existing building.



The back wall of the Auditorium has been removed and work is taking place behind a temporary wall, creating the area where hundreds of additional seats will be added. These areas will have operable walls that can be moved into place to allow these areas to be used for LIFE Groups and other meetings during the week.



This is the hallway that will take preschool parents to four of the five large preschool classrooms.



The areas in our existing building for our nursery and toddlers are being renovated to create a better environment for our youngest attenders.
